

# Six Sigma Green Belt Open-Enrolment Training



Duration: 10 Days

This course provides participants with the Six Sigma thinking, methods and tools to lead their own successful Green Belt projects. It is approved by external Six Sigma certification bodies including CRISSPI\* and the BQF\*\*.

## Contents

The training is structured around the DMAIC methodology and is delivered in 2 x 5 day blocks with approximately 1 month between blocks.

Week 1 covers the Define and Measure phases, Week 2 covers Analyse, Improve and Control. Please refer to separate Contents document for details. Comprehensive course notes are provided (included in price).



## Approach

Prior to training, participants select a suitable Six Sigma Project which they use to apply the training to a real-life problem while delivering business benefits (and more than repaying the training cost). Email / telephone support for project identification is included in the price.

During the classes there is a high emphasis on participation, practical exercises, application to the participants' own projects...and having fun!



The Define module uses a workshop approach. Participants apply the training immediately to their own projects with support from the instructor. We find this is a key enabler for rapid project start-up.

Minitab software is used to relieve the need for deep statistical knowledge and manual calculations.
